**Prayer before Communion:** 

All: Dear Lord, may we receive You in this Communion with open arms, and a loving, contrite heart, so that we may be filled with Your grace, for our good and Your glory! Amen.

## **WORDS OF INSTITUTION**

Pastor: On the night when he was betrayed, Jesus and his disciples gathered to eat the Passover meal. During supper Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks, broke the bread, gave it to the disciples, and said: "Take, eat: This is my body that is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

After supper Jesus took the cup, and after giving thanks, gave it to them and said: "Drink this, all of you. This is the new covenant in my blood. Do this in remembrance of me."

For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

All: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again. PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Pastor: The bread we break is the communion of the body of Christ. *Break the bread*.

The cup we bless is the communion of the blood of Christ. *Lift the cup*.

All: Jesus, lamb of God: have mercy on us. Jesus, bearer of our sins: have mercy on us. Jesus, redeemer of the world: give us your peace.

Pastor: Come, Holy Spirit, and consecrate this bread and this cup. Grant that all who share this communion with our risen Savior may be one in Christ, and sanctify us that we may remain faithful in love and hope until the final victory of your kingdom.

All: Through Him, with Him, in Him, in the unity of the Holy

Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, Almighty God, for ever and ever.

#### SHARING THE BREAD AND THE CUP

Pastor: The gifts of God for the people of God. Come, for all things are ready.

The servers come forward.

The bread is distributed.

The body of Jesus, given for you. Eat this and remember Him.

*The people eat the bread.* 

The cup is distributed.

The blood of Jesus, shed for the forgiveness of your sins. Drink this and remember Him.

The people drink the cup.

May this Holy Communion of the body and blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ keep and preserve you unto everlasting life.
